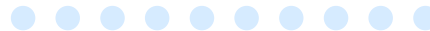

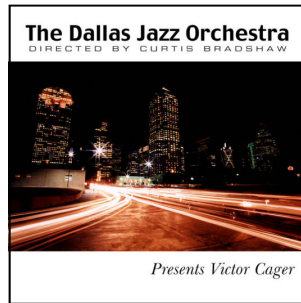

Big Band Jazz!

The words themselves conjure up a unique picture of sound: a wall of horns sounding like one big instrument pushed by a driving rhythm section. Then the wall opens a door and a soloist pushes through. The soloist challenges the wall or flirts with it, and then he is folded back within the wall as it presses on again. And the sound calls you forward, to listen, dance, to enjoy.

The Dallas Jazz Orchestra keeps this big band jazz tradition alive and the sound vibrant with inspired musicians, working together in ensemble or standing out as soloists, joyously playing music they want to play. And DJO Artistic Director Curt Bradshaw, a fine player in his own right, wrote many of the charts, writing and coaxing the best from this wonderful group of players.
